CRAFT: PRETEND SNOW (LOWER ELEMENTARY)

1. Mix together $3 - 1 = \underline{\quad}$ cups of kosher salt and $6 - 5 = \underline{\quad}$ cup of corn starch in a bowl.

2. Add $1 + 1 = \underline{\quad}$ cups of baking soda to a second mixing bowl. Then, spray $10 - 9 = \underline{\quad}$ can of shaving cream into the bowl and mix the ingredients together.

3. Add $1 + 0 = \underline{\quad}$ cup of baking soda to a mixing bowl or similar container. Then, add $8 - 7 = \underline{\quad}$ tablespoon of white hair conditioner. Mix to combine the ingredients. Continue to add $\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2} = \underline{\quad}$ tablespoon of conditioner at a time until the mixture forms a snow-like consistency.

Add glitter!
